For first time skaters, please sign up for Snowplow Sam or Basic 1 based on age.

What to Wear:

OUR PROGRAM

Our Classes:

Classes are taught in increments of 30 minutes. **Included with registration fee is one 30 minute instructional period per week and the public session on the day of their lesson.** Classes are held on Wednesdays from 5:10-5:40 with public skate before from 3-5pm, and Saturdays from 12pm-12:30 with public skate after from 12:30-2:10pm. Skating Edge follows the guidelines of Learn to Skate USA program, which is the governing body of the United States Figure Skating Association. Skills learned in our program will take your skater from the very basics to the elite skater they could become. Our instructors are all certified Figure Skating Instructors with full credentials and background screenings yearly.

Class Level Breakdown:

Snowplow Sam

Snowplow Sam class is geared towards your tot aged student, ages 3-6. Classes are meant to be fun, playful and skaters will progress at their own pace.

Basic 1

Skaters will begin to learn how to glide across the ice both forwards and backwards.

Basic 2-6

Beginning in Basic 2, skaters will learn the fundamentals of balance by gliding on one foot, and by Basic 6 your skater will be spinning on one foot.

Pre-Freeskate - Freeskate 6

Pre-Freeskate - Freeskate 6 is where your skater will learn the fundamentals of jumps and spins. By the completion of Freeskate 6 your skater will have learned multiple types of spins, jumps and even their Axel!
